ADULT SPORT LEAGUE CODE OF CONDUCT

I. CONDITIONS

- A. The Code of Conduct applies to all participants including players, coaches, managers, sponsors, and spectators involved in any Key Peninsula Metro Park District sponsored or co-sponsored adult leagues and tournaments.
- B. The code applies to participant conduct before, during and after all league and/or tournament games.
- C. Participants will be held liable for damages caused by misusing park facilities.
- D. It is the responsibility of each team manager to ensure that all participants and spectators know and adhere to the rules and regulations.

II. ENFORCEMENT

- A. The League Administrator has the power to impose penalties as prescribed within the Code of Conduct.
- B. The League Administrator will collect all necessary documentation and is responsible for notifying the team manager of the penalty being imposed. It is then the team manager's responsibility to inform the player(s) of the penalty.
- C. Within five business days, penalized participants may appeal in writing any decision made by the League Administrator.

III. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

- A. **STAGE 1:** Includes unsportsmanlike conduct, unnecessary roughness, etc.
Penalty: Ejection for remainder of game. Umpire will determine if penalty will be Stage 1 or Stage 2.
- B. **STAGE 2:** Same as Stage 1 only more severe.
Penalty: Ejection for remainder of game **plus the next two (2) scheduled games.**
- C. **STAGE 3:** Includes severe Stage 2 violations, including but not limited to, striking, pushing or threatening an official or participant, possession of alcoholic beverages on the field of play (including the dugouts), drugs or other major violations.

Penalty: **Immediate suspension. Automatic six (6) game suspension.** Player(s) will be placed on probation for one (1) year. Any further ejection while on probation will automatically be reviewed by the League Administrator for further action.
