## **RESOLUTION NO. R 2005-1**

A RESOLUTION BY THE KEY PENINSULA PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT REQUESTING THAT THE PIERCE COUNTY OFFICE OF BUDGET MANAGEMENT TAKE SUCH ACTION AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO FIND THAT THE FUND AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500), PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AN EMERGENCY CASH FUND FOR THE OPERATION OF THE DISTRICT, HAS, OVER A PERIOD OF MANY YEARS, MOST LIKELY BEEN SPENT FOR ITS INTENDED PURPOSE BUT FOR WHICH THERE IS NO ACCURATE ACCOUNTING AND THEREFORE DECLARE THE FUND CLOSED.

WHEREAS THE KEY PENINSULA PARK AND RECREATION BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS DID, AT AN EARLIER DATE IN THE FORMATION PERIOD OF THE PARK DISTRICT, APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$500.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AVAILABLE FUNDS FOR EMERGENCY PURCHASES; AND, WHEREAS THE FUNDS IN SAID ACCOUNT HAVE LONG SINCE BEEN USED FOR THE INTENDED PURPOSE AND REGRETABLY THERE IS NO RECORD OF HOW THE FUNDS WERE USED; NOW THEREFORE THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS RESPECTFULLY REQUEST THAT THE PIERCE COUNTY BUDGET DEPARTMENT DECLARE THAT THE FUNDS HAVE MOST PROBABLY BEEN USED IN AN APPROPRIATE MANNER AND THAT THE ACCOUNT SHOULD BE CLOSED.
