A RESOLUTION OF KEY PENINSULA METROPOLITIAN PARK DISTRICT (DBA KEY PEN PARKS) REGARDING ADOPTING THE PROTECTION OF FUTURE LEVY CAPACITY

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners of Key Peninsula Metropolitan Park District (DBA Key Pen Parks) has met and considered its budget for calendar year 2009; and

WHEREAS, the District's actual levy amount for 2009 tax year is \$ 600,000; and WHEREAS, the District's highest lawful levy amount is \$1,172,050.34

WHEREAS, the population of the District is more than 10,000; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners, has determined that, due to the expected demand for new recreation services such as acquisition of new parks and open space, development of recreation facilities and programs desired by local residents the District will not need to levy the entire amount permitted by law, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED by the Board of Park Commissioners that the District reserves the highest lawful levy capacity available in future years pursuant to RCW 84.55.092 and as otherwise permitted by law.

The foregoing resolution was adopted at a meeting of Board of Park Commissioners of the Key Pen Parks held on November 24, 2008.
