**WHEREAS**, Robert Droll and Associates presented at two Key Pen Parks study sessions, and held three public meetings on the Master Plan for Gateway Park October 9<sup>th</sup> and December 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014 and March 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, meet with Pierce County on Interagency Coordination and permits on March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Park Commissioners have met and made adjustments and changes deemed necessary and proper to the Master Plan for Gateway Park and that no Phasing plan is approved, now, therefore be it,

**RESOLVED** by the Board of Park Commissioners that Key Pen Parks adopts by reference the Master Plan E1 for Gateway Park.


