A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS OF THE KEY PENINSULA METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT ADOPTING THE 2023 ANNUAL BUDGET AT THE FUND LEVEL FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2023
