A RESOLUTION OF KEY PEN PARKS FOR SUBSTANTIAL NEED TO LEVY UP TO 1%

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners of Key Pen Parks has met and conducted public hearings on October 12, and November 9, 2015 to consider all relevant evidence and testimony regarding regular property taxes to be levied in 2015 for collection in 2016; and,


WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners finds that in order to protect future levy capacity, a substantial need exists to increase the limit factor by more than the calculation of 100% plus the implicit price deflator (IPD) of .251% to 1%; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Park Commissioners of Key Pen Parks has determined that substantial needed for the development of Key Pen Park's Park System;


