A RESOLUTION OF KEY PEN PARKS ADOPTING THE 2017 ANNUAL BUDGET AT THE FUND LEVEL FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2017

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Key Peninsula Metropolitan Park District (DBA Key Pen Parks) has recommended a balanced budget and estimate of monies required to meet public expenses for the 2017 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Board did cause to be published notices in the Key Peninsula News for the October 2016 and November 2016 issues that the Board of Park Commissioners would meet on October 10, 2016, and November 14, 2016 giving taxpayers an opportunity to be heard regarding the proposed 2017 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners did meet at the time specified and offered the opportunity for interested taxpayers, citizens, and residents to comment on the proposed budget as detailed below:

November 14, 2016	Public Hearing on Property Tax Levy


