

RULES

FOR A HAPPY OFF-LEASH DOG PARK

The off-leash area is for dogs, handlers, and those accompanying them. No other use is allowed. Dogs are the only animals permitted in this area. Use the off-leash area at your own risk.

DOGS MUST BE

- Currently licensed
- Up-to-date vaccinated and in good health
- Over four (4) months old
- Wearing a collar with visible ID tags
- On a leash until safely inside the off-leash area
- In view of their handler and under voice control of their handler at all times



OWNERS MUST

- Pick up and properly dispose of dog poop IMMEDIATELY
- Remain in the off-leash area with their dog(s) at all times
- Carry one leash per dog at all times
- Remove dogs at first sign of aggression
- Be liable for any and all injuries caused by their dog
- Fill any hole that their dog digs
- Limit three (3) dogs per handler

NOT ALLOWED

- Human food and dog food/treats
- Glass containers
- Dogs in heat
- Sick dogs
- Aggressive dogs
- Excessive barking (*be kind to park neighbors*)
- Wheeled vehicles (*bicycles, etc.*)
- Unsupervised children under 13 years of age
